The mission of Disney Elementary School is to create a community of learners while striving to provide students with a safe and nurturing environment, supporting every educational, developmental and social need

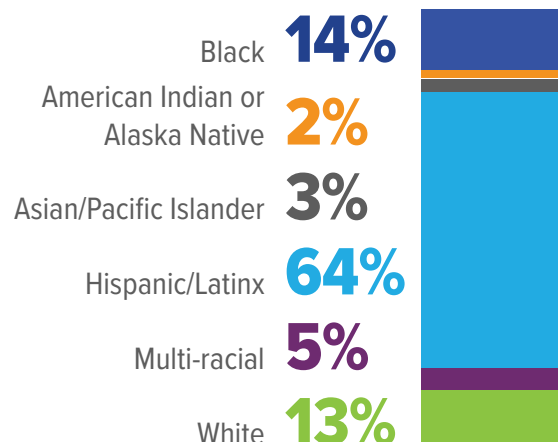
### FOCUS ON THE WHOLE CHILD

We utilize the Second Step Learning Model, which incorporates lessons on bullying prevention and child safety into the daily academic curriculum. Creating high-quality learning experiences means educating the whole child by meeting his or her social, emotional, and academic needs. Social and emotional learning (SEL) is the process through which children and adults acquire and effectively apply the knowledge, attitudes, and skills necessary to understand and manage emotions.

With strong social and emotional skills, our students will be able to set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions.

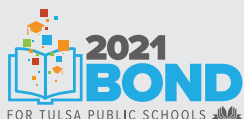
## TWO-WAY DUAL LANGUAGE PROGRAM

Beginning in pre-K or kindergarten, students in the program will speak two different native languages and receive instruction in both English and Spanish. Bilingual children who are educated in their second language have been seen to outperform single language children in their native language.

Bilingualism also increases brain cognition by utilizing the highest levels of thinking, focus, and awareness.
